NOTE: In order for us to accept your officer's (including auxiliary officers) registration for this course, it is necessary for you to provide a copy of the officer's Form E. For sworn officers this form should have already been forwarded and placed on file with the IL Law Enforcement Training & Standards Board. A list of all officers enrolled will be sent, one week prior to the first day of the course, to the ILETSB for verification before the class begins. If an officer attempts to enroll, but does not send a copy of the Form E to our office by the due date, that officer will not be accepted into the class. In addition, auxiliary officers must have a letter from their police department sent to W.I.P.T.U. stating they are not being utilized as part-time officers.

All paperwork must be received by W.I.P.T.U. no later than April 27, 2011.

 2. COMPLETE Duty Leather
(Belt, holster, ammo case as worn on duty)
 3. Eye and Ear Protection
 4. 850 Rounds of Ammunition
(Either New or Remanufactured by a Retail Concern or Company)
NO "HOUSE-MADE" OR "HOME RELOADS" ALLOWED!
 5. 50 Rounds regular duty ammo
 6. 12 Ga. Shotgun which is authorized by the trainee's department
(If sending more than one officer, send a shotgun for each officer)
 7. 5 Rounds of either #4 Buck or .00 Buck, 5 Rounds of Rifle slug,
and 25 Rounds of field load
 8. Rain gear
 9. Flashlight

Each student must gain a passing score of at least 70% on the written test and score two 70% or more targets to fulfill the requirements of the law for successful completion of this class.
