PROGRAM INTENT: This course is offered to state and local law enforcement agencies. It is designed to prepare the breath alcohol operator for actual operation of the instrument. It will address such issues as laws surrounding DUI arrests, physiology and pharmacology of alcohol in the human body, theories of breath testing, operation of breath test instruments and courtroom preparation and presentation.

GENERAL STATEMENT: This program will be held during a 3 day/24-hour period. Training will be delivered through lecture and practical exercises. Students must achieve 70% on a written examination administered by the Illinois Department of Public Health in order to be licensed as a Breath Analyzer Operator.
