**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** *This is the same course as taught at the Illinois State Police Academy.* There have been several changes to the Illinois Vehicle Code this year. This course covers the entire Illinois Vehicle Code and the Illinois Supreme Court Rules concerning bonding procedures. If you are an officer with patrol duties, returning to patrol from another assignment, part-time, or just need a refresher this course is for you. In this course special attention will be given to the strict construction of the wording of traffic laws, procedures for charging a traffic offense, the major differences in enforcing violations of state laws and city ordinances, the application of Miranda warnings to traffic cases, the most frequent problems encountered in traffic enforcement, and clearing up common bonding misconceptions and errors.
