ABOUT THE COURSE:

Theft of vehicles has long been a major law enforcement problem. This is an eight hour course geared toward patrol officers on aspects of the auto theft problem. The course material will cover the steps necessary to deter, detect and apprehend offenders of this crime and will cover the applicable anti-vehicle theft laws. Also covered will be altered VINs and the Illinois Vehicle Title System.

The course will provide the student insight into vehicle theft techniques and methods used to enter and steal vehicles, and methods to detect an altered manufacturer's VIN. Vehicle ID resources will be shared, such as using the NICB and its many data bases and accessing motor vehicle theft task force operations.
